- Meeting began with introductions of the meeting members and brief legislative update of bills
- Andre McGregor presented on the current landscape of AI in emergency response and public safety broadly. The presenter out trends in decision-making and threat analysis and gave overview of technologies available for procurement.
- A question is asked about metrics for success or performance that deployers or law enforcement agencies look at for these technologies. A concern is called out of the impacts if specifics metrics are chosen as indicators of success.
- The presenter responds depending on the technology, impact, and even agency metrics for success or deployer looks different.
- A meeting member makes a comment about how different entities have a different risk assessment for these technologies. Those assessments are weighed heavily.
- A question is asked about how these technologies are deployed with consideration of the negative effects concerning data and security. A meeting member responds that these systems are trained on the highest quality of data available and not solely relied upon to mitigate the chances of AI hallucinations.
