What we help with

- Hate crimes (assault, threats, and property damage motivated by bias)
- Bias incidents (hostile or discriminatory language or behavior)
- Connections to local, culturally competent support available in multiple languages

When you contact us

- You speak with a trained team member—access to interpretation in over 240 languages
- You get information and referrals
- You choose what to do next

What we **don't** do

- Emergency response (call 911 if in danger)
- Criminal investigations
- We do not contact the police, unless you want us to
