Shanelle Sunde. and Sunde 15 Consulting & Accounting LLC, entered August 26, 2025, the Court hereby enters judgment in 16 favor of the Plaintiff State of Washington against Defendants Shanelle Sunde and Sunde 17 Consulting & Accounting LLC (hereafter Judgment Defendants) as follows: 18 Restitution A. 19 2.2 Pursuant to RCW 19.86.080(2), Judgment Defendants are liable for and are 20 hereby ordered to pay a total of \$584,576.88 in restitution for the money or property, real or 21 personal, which they unlawfully acquired from the affected estates through their unlawful, 22 unfair, and deceptive acts and practices identified in this litigation. 23 2.3 To the extent that restitution is available to be paid from the estate trust accounts 24 that Judgment Defendants created for the benefit of specific estates, that portion of the total 25 restitution amount shall be paid from those trust accounts as directed by the Court. 26

- 2.4 Judgment Defendants shall pay the remaining restitution (i.e., the amount remaining after subtracting the funds paid from specific estate trust accounts as set forth in Paragraph 2.3) to the Attorney General within 30 days of this judgment by valid check or wire transfer as set forth in Paragraph 3.1 below.
- 2.5 The Attorney General will distribute restitution to the affected estates and consumers from these funds in the manner and amounts that will most effectively address the harm, at the sole discretion of the Attorney General.

B. Injunction

- 2.6 Pursuant to RCW 19.86.080(1), Judgment Defendants are hereby permanently RESTRAINED and ENJOINED as follows:
 - a. The Court previously issued a TRO freezing the 75 identified estate accounts controlled by Judgment Defendants, along with 11 identified non-fiduciary accounts into which they transferred estate funds. Dkt. 26. To permanently protect these funds, the Court subsequently converted the TRO to a permanent injunction which remains in effect. Dkt. 125;
 - Judgment Defendants are prohibiting from acting as professional administrators or executors in any future probate matters in the State of Washington; and
 - c. Judgment Defendants shall not engage in any other conduct that violates the Consumer Protection Act, RCW 19.86, or Washington's probate laws.

C. Civil Penalties

2.7 Pursuant to RCW 19.86.140, Judgment Defendants are liable for and are hereby ordered to pay civil penalties to the Plaintiff State of Washington in the amount of \$1,087,000.00 as detailed in the Court's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order Granting State's Motion for Default Judgment, entered July 11, 2025. Dkt. 125.

Costs and Attorneys' Fees D.

- 2.8 Pursuant to RCW 19.86.080(1), Judgment Defendants are liable for and are hereby ordered to pay Plaintiff State of Washington's attorney fees and costs in the amount of \$789,763.51, as detailed in the Court's Order Granting State's Petition for Fees and Costs Against Defendants John Elliott, Probate & Administration Services LLC, Aurora Creek Ranch LLC, Shanelle Sunde, and Sunde Consulting & Accounting LLC, entered August 26, 2025. Dkt. 132.
- 2.9 The Court's Order Granting State's Petition for Fees and Costs, Dkt. 132, granted attorney's fees and costs jointly and severally against Defendants John Elliott, Probate & Administration Services LLC, Aurora Creek Ranch LLC, Shanelle Sunde, and Sunde Consulting & Accounting LLC. Id. The attorney's fees and costs ordered against these Defendants are, therefore, offset by any amount paid by Defendants John Elliott, Probate & Administration Services LLC, and Aurora Creek Ranch LLC in satisfaction of the attorney's fees and costs ordered against those Defendants by separate judgment.

PAYMENT AND ENFORCEMENT III.

- 3.1 All payments made to satisfy this Judgment shall be in the form of a valid check or wire transfer paid to the order of the "Attorney General – State of Washington." Payments shall be sent to the Office of the Attorney General, Attention: Margaret Farmer, Litigation Support Manager, 800 Fifth Avenue, Suite 2000, Seattle, Washington 98104-3188.
- 3.2 Nothing in this Judgment shall be construed as to limit or bar any other government entity or any consumer in pursuit of other remedies against Judgment Defendants. Representatives of the Office of the Attorney General shall be permitted, upon reasonable notice to Judgment Defendants, to access and inspect all business records or documents under the control of Judgment Defendants to monitor compliance with the terms of this Judgment.
- 3.3 Pursuant to RCW 19.86.140, any violation of the terms of this Judgment shall form the basis for further enforcement proceedings, including, but not limited to, contempt of
