Hi Alicia,

Representative Wallen has requested an informal AG opinion related to [RCW 9.41.110](#). Can you please let me know what the timeline will possibly be on getting an informal opinion? Thanks and let me know if you have any questions.

- 1) Do cable-locking firearms to a display meet the secure storage requirement?
 - 10)(a) Dealers shall secure each firearm during business hours, except when the firearm is being shown to a customer, repaired, or otherwise worked on, **in a manner that prevents a customer or other member of the public from accessing or using the firearm**, which may include keeping the firearm in a locked container or in a locked display case.
- 2) Clarification that video security systems must be capable of recording 24 hours a day, but don't need to be doing so, as long as they can be activated well enough to capture what they need to assist in any theft investigation, etc.
 - (11)(a)...(iv) The system shall be **capable of** recording 24 hours per day at a frame rate no less than 15 frames per second, and must either (A) record continuously or (B) **be activated by motion and remain active for at least 15 seconds after motion ceases to be detected;**
